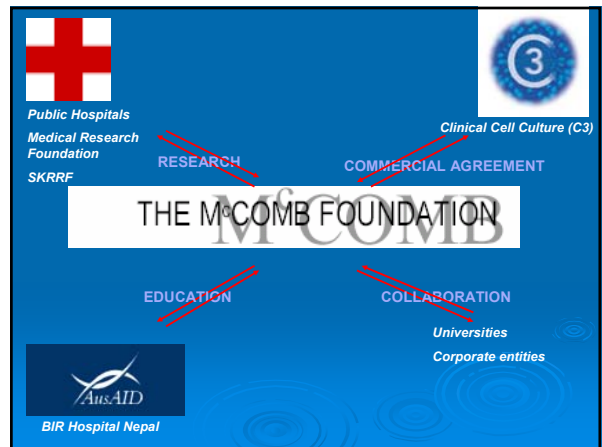

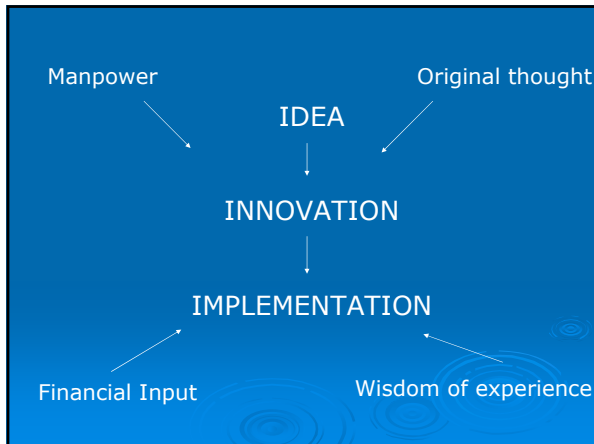
Burns

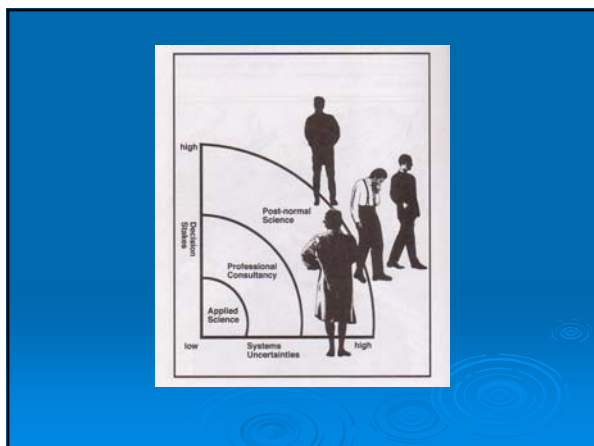
